Follow the traffie rules in Japan!

Stop at a "止まれ(=STOP)" sign.



Many of the traffic accidents causing injuries often occur at an intersection.

Make sure to stop at a "止まれ (=STOP)" sign and look both sides at an intersection.

You need to keep driving a vehicle including bicycles on the left side of the road.



Vehicles include both cars and bicycles. Keep on the left side while driving. Driving on the right side can cause a serious accident. Drive carefully not to drive on the right side.

Pedestrians have the priority at a crosswalk.


When pedestrians are about to cross a crosswalk, you need to stop.

When approaching a crosswalk, make sure that there are no pedestrians.


Make sure to check the traffic light carefully

Prohibited to drive a car or bicycle under the

influence of alcohol.



Driving after drinking alcohol is prohibited.

Even if you don't drive,

- being with a drunk driver in the same vehicle
- providing with a vehicle to a drinker
- providing with alcohol to a driver are prohibited.
