In 1906, Urata Tadako opened a hospital in Ushibuka. It was for patients with eye problems. She worked hard for them.

One day she was asked to come and teach at Gakushuin Women's College in Tokyo. She thought it over and she decided to work as a teacher in Tokyo.

However, as she was teaching there, she began to believe that her true work was to help patients. With her husband, she visited her mentor Kitasato Shibasaburo and talked with him about it. He was from Kumamoto too. Shibasaburo said, "There are not many specialists in China. Why don't you go there to help sick people?"



Tadako said, "We'll go there to help them"

In 1912, she opened the Doujin Hospital in Tianjin. Many people from different countries lived there. Tadako spoke to her Chinese patients in Chinese, her German patients in German, and her British and American patients in ·patient 患者 ·eye problems 眼病

She didn't take money from such poor patients. Sometimes she even gave money to her patients. All her life was for other people.

After she came back to Japan, she opened a hospital in Tokyo. She worked hard as a doctor until she died at the age of 64.
